#### Miscommunication

May 2021

There is an old Saturday Night Live skit that has always stuck out in my mind. In this skit, Ed Asner is portraying a retiring nuclear power plant employee. As he is leaving, he is giving his replacement important instructions...

"You can't add too much water to the reactor."

Later in the skit, you see the new employee trying to determine what Ed meant by these words... was it that you shouldn't add too much water, or that you can never add enough water to the reactor. Of course, at the end of the skit, you see Ed sitting on a beach somewhere and in the distance, you see an explosion and the ensuing mushroom cloud.

Ok, so why am I reminiscing on 30+ year-old shows? It's all about being clear in our communication. Since we have been Live Streaming our services, I have seen some very positive comments from viewers that are enjoying our videos. However, every once-in-a-while, I see a negative emoji. If you don't know what an emoji is, it is the little smiley face symbol  $\bigcirc$  or heart symbol, or frown  $\bigotimes$  plus many others. When we see a negative emoji, a frown, or something similar, we are not sure why the person put it out there. Was it supposed to be a smile, and they hit the wrong button? Or did the really dislike something in our service. Communication is key. We are working on getting our services back to some normalcy. If there is something that you don't like, please let us know. I take all comments (good and bad) seriously, and we try to rectify any negative feedback. However, if we just see a frown  $\bigotimes$ , we are not sure what was disliked. With that in mind, here are some comments that I have received recently and what we are doing to fix them.

- When are the pew cushions coming back?
  - The Pew cushions are coming back in the next week or so. As are the hymnals and Bibles.
- When are we going to have traditional hymns?
  - We are putting together a schedule to have some Sundays each month contain more traditional hymns and organ music. This may not start until July when pastor becomes full-time
- What about the banners that hangs on each side of the church?
  - We took the banners down when we started video recording our services way back last year.
     We will be getting those back in place in the coming weeks.
- When will we go to 1 service instead of 2.
  - We will be going to 1 service starting in June. See more information around the summer schedule below.
- Does the church have a scholarship fund for High School Graduates?
  - See below.

<u>Scholarship Fund -</u> Several years ago, we created a scholarship fund for graduating high-school senior members. However, a few years later, it was removed from the budget. The council has decided to re-instate the scholarship fund. If you have a graduating high-school senior that is planning on going to a college, university, or trade-school, then applications will be available in the church office. The scholarship amounts are capped at \$500. The applicant must meet a few criteria which are outlined in the application packet.

I believe that is all for now. See you Sunday, Eric.



1.) Please wear a mask while in the building and around other members.



#### 3.) IF YOU DO NOT FEEL WELL, PLEASE STAY HOME!


- A sanitizing table will be set in the Elevator Entrance, in the education areas, and by entrances to the sanctuary.
